Dulcimer teacher, arranger, and performer; pianist, upright bassist, and all-around nice person!

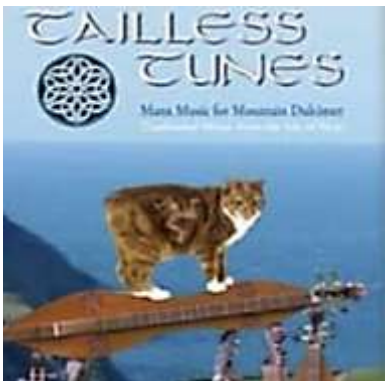
### Tailless Tunes -- Traditional Manx Music -- Int / Adv (Various tunings / capo)

This tiny island, located in the Irish Sea, is an untapped source of beautiful music with Celtic influences. In this session, your journey will begin with repertoire selections, including lively jigs and reels, and haunting ballads and lullabies. I'll share my photographs of the original manuscripts of tunes collected by the Manx "songcatchers" during the 1890s, and of the places where these tunes originated. We'll follow the evolution of these melodies as they develop into modern day arrangements for mountain dulcimer. You'll even learn a bit of Manx Gaelic in the process!
